Qualified Candidates Must Meet the Following Criteria:

- Shall be 18 years of age
- Shall be a registered voter
- Shall be a resident of Illinois and District 92 for at least 1 year
- Shall not be a child sex offender as defined in Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal code of 1961
- Shall not have been convicted of an infamous crime as such term is defined in Section 124-1 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 unless restored to such rights by a pardon or otherwise by law

Information that must be provided by candidate:

- Standard Personal Information – name, address, telephone number, email address
- Numbers of years you have lived in the district
- Reason for your interest in the position

All candidates will be subject to a background check.

- Personal information and the results of any background check will be kept confidential to the full extent permitted by law.

Following a review, the board will schedule interviews with the proposed candidates.
