**Question posed:**

We are concerned that we have not been provided student addresses in order to formulate hypothetical routes for the transportation service. Without this information we cannot make an informed decision on the driver labor hours and mileage for fuel and vehicle maintenance in order to formulate a hypothetical routes. This makes it difficult for us to prepare a bid for these services as we will be taking a significant risk on the two largest cost factors to the operation without having these particulars.


We are concerned that other contractors who are not the incumbent contractor may also take this stance and could limit the number of competitive bids that you would receive.

Would it be possible to obtain for the addresses of the students for each route/route listing as you have provided in the bid documents?

Names can be omitted and if you needed further assurance, you can provide a clarifying statement with the info that contractors are to keep it confidential and solely used for routing purposes for the bid.

**Answer:**

No. That is confidential information and cannot be provided. In preparing your bid, you can refer to Exhibit A, knowing the students live somewhere in the 18 square mile radius of the district boundary lines. Exhibit D lists the name of the outplacement facility. You can make a reasonable decision using that information.
