14 Do you have a computerized routing software?



Contractor performs the routing. District 92 does not have routing software.

Answer:

Grand Prairie is currently in a contractual relationship with District 92. As such, they are in a position to be in control of proprietary information and are held responsible if they violate the Illinois School Student Records Act (see p. 53 of the bid documents). Other bidders are not in a contractual relationship with District 92. Bidders have been provided with enough information to estimate costs. Additionally, the current addresses could potentially change if students move within the district between now and next year, or if new students move into the district.
